**Non prize winning entries completing the route will receive an appearance award as follows: -**

**Class 1 and 3** - £220 for entries placed 5<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>, all other entries will receive £200. **Class 5 and 6** - £160 for entries placed 5<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup>, all other entries will receive £140. **Classes 7 and 8** - £15. **Class 9** - £25. **Classes 10 and 11** - £40. **Class 14** - £25.

#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – (Please note by submitting an entry form you are agreeing to all the following conditions)

**IMPORTANT.** It is essential all mounted entries abide by the instructions contained within the Bridgwater Guy Fawkes Carnival Committee Code of Practice; copies are obtainable from the Secretary. In addition due notice must be given to the Working Guide to the management of Carnival Vehicles compiled by the Avon and Somerset Constabulary in conjunction with the D.E.T.R and the requirement to hold a valid Vehicle Special Order (VSO) licence to travel on the highway and enter the procession.

#### **MAXIMUM DIMENSIONS (Procession only)**

**Height:            5.33 metres.            Width:            3.35 metres.            Length:            30.48 metres.**

#### **AGE RESTRICTIONS:**

**Please note that all entrants in the carnival with the exception of a fully mounted entry should be 5 years or over. If entering classes 6, 8, or 11 entrants should also be under 17 years on the 1st November 2009.**

- Class 1 - 5      Entry must be fully mounted with a minimum of 8 personnel on the entry. Class 2 & 4 are restricted to Bridgwater Gangs & Feature entries. Do you also want to enter class 12 or 13?
- Class 6        Entry must be fully mounted with a minimum of 6 personnel on the entry. Do you also want to enter class 12 or 13?
- Class 7 & 8    One costumed person with or without props and self-propelled permitted, sound & light accompaniment is also permitted, but not by the use of motor vehicles. One ground crew member permitted (two for class 8) to aid the entry in any way (must be adequately defined as road crew, not in costume).
- Class 9 & 14   Any combination of age – self-propelled with or without props.
- Class 10 & 11 A minimum of 6 people. A float or other wheeled prop(s) towed or propelled by physical or mechanical means with or without a maximum of 3 personnel on board is permitted, sound accompaniment is permitted. Do you also want to enter class 12 or 13?
- Class 12       Any entry with a decorated towing vehicle can enter this class.
- Class 13       Any entry with a costumed towing vehicle driver can enter this class.

- A) Please note that the responsibility for obtaining a Performing Rights Society licence will this year be the responsibility of the town organising committee, therefore if you receive a reminder to renew the PRS licence you obtained last year you **do not** need to renew it to enter the carnival.
- B) On submitting your entry you confirm that you have obtained all necessary licences and your entry will not infringe any copyright, you accept that any infringement of copyright is the responsibility of the entrant and not the carnival you are entering and that the carnival committee will not accept any responsibility for any action taken for copyright infringement by your entry.
- C) You are advised that excess advertising or words of thanks on your entry could result in point's deduction.
- D) Competitive entries only will be accepted in classes 1 – 14. Trade entries will not be accepted in any of these classes.
- E) Floats failing to comply with the permitted measurements will be directed away from the procession assembly by a marshal.
- F) Towing vehicles, carts and generators must be "coupled up" by 5.00p.m. to enable the total entry length to be checked.

- G) Carts failing to comply with instructions to rectify faults with their entry may be disqualified.
- H) The towing vehicle driver must be available to remove the entry from the assembly area as directed by a marshal or police officer.
- I) Any entry which is considered to be of a vulgar or objectionable nature and likely to cause controversy will be refused.
- J) If the procession halts for more than two minutes entries shall be permitted to relax until the procession restarts.
- K) In all matters of dispute the ruling of the Procession Officer in agreement with the President and Chairman will be final and binding.
- L) Any entries failing to abide by these Conditions of Entry will not be allowed into the procession.
- M) All entries take part in the procession at their own risk and responsibility.
- N) If further information is required please contact the Entries Secretary.
