The fun starts early on Bridgwater Carnival Day. From 10am the streets echo with the sounds of live music, street theatre, marching bands and fun for the whole family. Come early and join in the Carnival Party!

FIREWORKS & FAIRGROUND

A Grand Firework Display, sponsored by Bridgwater Town Council, provides the perfect opening event for Bridgwater Carnival. Held in St Matthew's Field, courtesy of Sedgemoor District Council, this is one of the largest displays in the South West,

with the added attraction of family fairground rides for everyone to enjoy.


Town Hall, Bridgwater Evenings (times vary)



Some 50 carnival carts, up to 30m long, 5.5m high, 3.5m wide, create an amazing spectacle of light, sound and mindblowing movement as the parade winds it's way along a two mile route in the centre of our historic town. Groups and individual masqueraders, marching bands and so much more complete the line-up which takes over two hours to pass you by. The parade starts at 6pm - but you need to arrive much earlier to sample the full Bridgwater Carnival Experience, which culminates with the unique -

SIMULTANEOUS SQUIBBING DISPLAY

The tradition of squibbing goes back centuries and can only be seen in Bridgwater. The display takes place in the High Street 30 minutes after the parade ends. When it comes to fireworks, nothing matches this incredible display on the streets
